Candidates must meet the following mandatory qualifications:

- Proof of Grade 12 education or equivalent
- Be at least 18 years of age
- Be legally eligible to work in Canada
- Have not been convicted of a criminal offense for which a pardon has not been granted (Successful candidates will required to submit a satisfactory Vulnerable Sector Screening upon hire)
- a valid Ontario class D driver's license (with a Z endorsement) in good standing
- NFPA-1001 Firefighter I & II certification (Including NFPA 472 or 1072)
- a valid Standard First Aid and a CPR Level "C" certificate (minimum)
- successful completion of all seven components of the Fire Services of Ontario (FSO) testing

Application Process

Candidates must pre-register for testing with Firefighter Services of Ontario by **4:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 6, 2023**. For candidates who have already completed the FSO testing please refer to the Recruitment Guide for instructions.

The position offers an annual salary of \$76,247 to \$101,663 (2020 rates) plus a competitive benefit package. Salary will be commensurate with experience based on candidates' current rank.
